FAQs

What is Grab & Go? Browse new and bestselling books for all ages in the lobby or try our new themed Book and Movie Bundles when the library is open for Grab & Go. You can also pick up any holds you have available, browse the adult collection, and staff can retrieve items for you from other areas of the library. Check out at the Circulation Desk, or try our new Self Service kiosk.

Do I need to make an appointment? You do not need an appointment for Grab & Go, but to help limit risk and increase access for others, please keep your visit brief and your party small. Due to reduced capacity there may be a brief wait when you visit.

What guidelines do I need to follow?

- Face coverings that completely cover your nose and mouth are required for the duration of your visit.
- Do not visit if you currently have or recently had a fever, cough, shortness of breath, are feeling unwell, have had close contact with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19, or have been outside the country or visited any states that are not designated as a lower COVID-19 risk within the past 14 days.
- Practice physical distancing (6 feet) inside and outside the library.
- Follow the instructions of the library staff regarding wait times to enter the building, new safety policies, and using equipment safely.
- Use library-supplied hand sanitizer before entering the building, and before and after touching materials and surfaces.
- Continue to return all materials to the outdoor book and media drops.

Can I browse throughout the library? At this time browsing is limited to the collection in the lobby. Staff can retrieve materials for you and we're happy to make recommendations.

Can I sit to read or work? At this time, we ask that you keep your visits to the library brief. Study rooms are closed and seating has been removed.

Can I visit the Children's Room? The Children's Room and Discovery Den will remain closed for the time being. The colorful and fun books, toys, and games present too many tempting high-touch surfaces. New and high-interest books from the Children's Room will be available in the lobby for limited browsing.

Can I still use Contactless Pickup? Yes, you can continue to make appointments for Contactless Pickup
